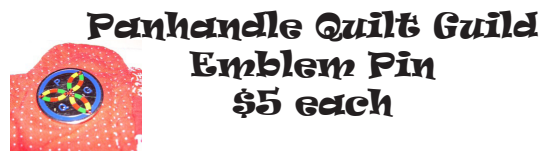

Tips for Binding Scalloped Edges

Mark scalloped edge on a quilt but DO NOT cut on that edge until the binding is sewn on. If the edge is cut before binding you risk stretching and fraying of the scallops.

Baste along the marked edge. This will hold layers together and keep them from shifting while binding.

Always use a bias binding to bind curved or scalloped edges. A single bias binding cut at 1 1/4" is best. (Wrights Wide Single Fold Bias Tape is the right size and comes in many easy to match colors!) A double binding is too bulky at the inside corner of the scallop.

To make a softly rounded corner, start marking the quilt edge with Easy Scallop positioned right to the adjacent edge. To make a pointed corner or "ear", begin with half of scallop at the corner.

A scalloped edge can take an ordinary quilt and make it extra-ordinary!

PROGRESSIVE ROW-BY-ROW PARTICIPANTS

You should bring to the January meeting:

1. Your container holding your "starter" row
2. Up to one yard of fabric(s)
3. The label/list that explains your row - with plenty of room for the others to add their explanations

Check the "Owner" instructions section of the project instructions found in the Oct newsletter (page 7) or on the website for more details.

Each group has a "Founding Mother" and four other members of various years of membership. Each group will receive a booklet of past block of the month and President's block? patterns, but you may also use/or be inspired by any classes held during each time period. The groups are:

Get together at each meeting, be inspired by items brought for display and the printed pattern booklets, and pass the project to the next person on the list, i.e. Jan to Karen, Karen to Dorothy, Dorothy to Ramona, Ramona to Jodee, Jodee to Jan. If you can't attend a meeting, please have a friend bring your project so that it 'progresses' each month.



JANUARY CLASSES

Ramona Einfalt presents ULTIMATE QUILT TOTE

The most versatile quilt bag you can find. Large enough to hold all tools and materials for class. Supported bottom allows carrying on top of rolling sewing machine case with ease. Holds 13"x24" cutting mat and 24" rulers.

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- ✓ 2 3/4 yd FEATURE fabric (outside of bag).
Batiks not recommended for this bag.
- ✓ 2 3/4 yd LINING fabric (inside of bag)
- ✓ 2 3/4 yd low loft poly or cotton batting
OR, you may use 2 3/4 yd pre-quilted fabric rather than the 3 fabrics listed above
- ✓ 2 1/4 yd POCKET fabric (may be same as inside fabric)
- ✓ 1 yd coordinating fabric for binding
- ✓ 1 (one) large button-1/4" to 2"
- ✓ 4" Hook and Loop fastener (not adhesive backed)
- ✓ 2 pcs 5/8" wooden dowel, 24" long
- ✓ 1 (one) 6 1/4" x 23 1/2" stiffener panel-may be plywood, cardboard or acrylic.
(I will have acrylic available for purchase at class if you let me know you want it)



QUILT FABRICS AS DESIRED BEFORE THEY ARE CUT TO FINAL SIZE

If fabric is going to longarm machine one large piece is best. If you are quilting it on home machine it will need to be cut into smaller pieces for ease in handling. Fabrics will quilt up so cut pieces oversized by 2" on all sides.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

QUILTED FABRIC:

- ✓ 2 (two) 26"x24" pcs for front and back
- ✓ 2 (two) 26"x18" for outside pockets
- ✓ 1 (one) 64"x8" pc for bottom and sides
- ✓ 1 (one) 25"x8" for stiffener pocket

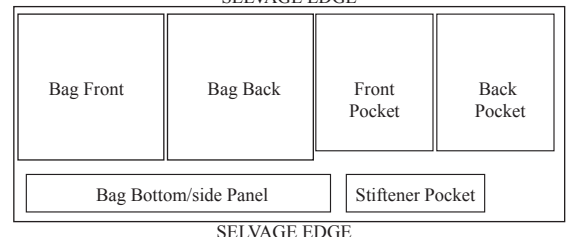
LINING FABRIC:

- ✓ 2 (two) 30"x26" pcs inside pocket
- ✓ 1 (one) 20"x26" pc for small inside pocket
- ✓ 2 (two) 10"x8" pc for side pockets

BINDING:

- ✓ Four (4) strips WOF 2" for pocket edges
- ✓ Four (4) strips WOF 3 1/4" for body of bag
- ✓ Two (2) 13X2" pcs, on bias, for handle opening

JANUARY CLASSES CONTINUED

Jan Sears presents MINIATURE QUILT

FABRICS:

Fat quarters (18"x22") of 3-6 different fabrics, in lights and darks. Small-scale prints or solids are best. Scraps may be used. Theme suggestions are: scrap look, Christmas Amish, controlled color scheme. Small figures for fancy cuts for attic windows block. Fabrics should be pre-washed and starched and ironed.

SUPPLY LIST:

- ✓ Rotary cutting tools-mat, cutter, ruler with 1/8" marks and a small bias square. NOTE: Instructor will have these on hand if you wish to use them.
- ✓ Sewing machine in good working order with straight stitch throat plate and fine sharp needles: 80/12 or smaller.
- ✓ Thread in a neutral color or to match fabric. Suggestions are: Mettler 100% Cotton 60/2 or Mettler Metrosene polyester. You might try silk thread.
- ✓ Scissors, ripper, pencil
- ✓ Fine long straight silk pins, if possible
- ✓ Some other necessary supplies will be provided
- ✓ Iron, small ironing board, extension cords, et cetera-will probably need to share these
